Summary (in English)

Heraldry and vexillology as auxiliary historical sciences can bring significant inspiration and stimuli to civic education in secondary education (according to the international classification ISCED – International Standard Classification of Education) ISCED 2 and ISCED 3. Using the example of a state entity – the Margraviate of Moravia – in the territory of Moravia in the years 1182–1918, its rulers, coats of arms and flags, we present the connection of the abovementioned auxiliary historical sciences, historical local history and subject-specific didactics of social sciences in constructing research-based teaching of civic and social science fundamentals.
